- 1. All must be at least 16 years old by June 1, 2023.
- 2. You must be a GOALIE for goalie camp, and any skating position for DEFENSE Camp.
- 3. All must possess a unique passion for the sport and working with youngsters
- 4. All must take direction well, yet be able to "process and figure it out"
- 5. All receive a "camp stipend" and lunch daily
- 6. No transportation or accommodations are provided by the camp.
- 7. Selections are "competitive" and "time sensitive".
- 8. If selected, a contract and counselor procedures are provided via email
- 9. There is no hard deadline. When spots are gone, they are gone.
